Intercollegiate Specialty Examinations - Section 2 Update

I thought a brief update would be helpful for all Section 2 Candidates in advance of more detailed specialty-specific information being cascaded by the Secretariat in the very near future. As always, everyone at the JCIE is very appreciative of your patience and understanding in the face of the challenges posed by the pandemic.

I previously intimated that the JCIE would arrange replacement Section 2 diets for every examination that was subject to a pandemic-enforced cancellation and this remains the case. The dates and venues of these replacement Section 2 examinations are now confirmed and are listed below. In keeping with the JCIE's previous commitment to the candidate pool, the fourth column of the table lists candidates who are **guaranteed a place** in the respective examination diet. Such candidates are those who were already enrolled for an examination and/or have suffered an examination postponement. **Please note, however, that these are not the only candidates that will be accommodated in each examination;** the JCIE Secretariat will offer places up to the maximum number of Candidates who can be accommodated, and the Secretariat team is currently working hard to maximise that number while taking in to account the outcome of recent Section 1 examinations.

Examination scheduling is, however, a complex task and depends not only on the total number of Examiners who are available but on their sub-specialty mix. Please rest assured that we are doing everything we can to offer places to every candidate who is eligible and wishes to take Section 2 between now and the summer. It may be that a waiting list is required in some specialties but that is the norm rather than an exception. Everyone, however, can play their part in keeping that possibility to a minimum. What can be frustrating for all concerned are late withdrawals that result in Section 2 diets not being fully utilised. With that in mind the JCIE would appreciate early notice from any Candidate who wishes to defer to a later examination date so that the space can be offered in a timely manner to one of your peers who otherwise might be held on a waiting list.
